50+ organizations, lawmakers partner on behalf of nation's children

<u>Children's Week 2023</u> kicks off Monday, June 12 with a conversation about current threats to public education and how to protect our nation's students.

Events, which run through June 17, will feature **interviews**, **briefings**, **and in-person meet-ups with federal and state lawmakers**, **members of the Administration**, **advocates**, **and academics** on topics including what children and parents need and want, how to combat economic inequality, and the social and economic benefits of investing in children.

This annual event from <u>First Focus on Children</u> comes as American youth struggle with challenges including a mental health crisis, rising mortality rates, anti-child discrimination in their schools, sports and other programs, and general threats to their well-being. **More than 50 organizations and multiple members of Congress have partnered with First Focus on Children to spotlight and propose solutions to these issues throughout <u>Children's Week 2023</u> and beyond.**
