


Research shows that voters are behind us. In a pre-election survey, [an overwhelming majority — regardless of political affiliation](#) — said that federal policy and budgets should be set according to a “best interest of the child” standard. There’s never been a better time than now.

### **Because.....**

- [Every aspect of children's lives](#) has been affected by the pandemic.
- For the first time in decades, [children have a place in the national conversation](#).

For instance, take the (very) preliminary Senate budget. The document reportedly includes **\$150 billion mainly aimed at creating a path to lawful permanent resident status for protected categories** such as DACA beneficiaries, farmworkers, essential workers and those with Temporary Protected Status from certain countries. Roughly **5 million** children have parents who are undocumented, including DACA recipients, recipients of Temporary Protected Status, or essential workers or farmworkers. Another **725,000+ kids** are themselves undocumented.

Other goodies in the package are said to include **money for maternal and behavioral health** programs, as well as **bigger pieces of pie** than President Biden offered for **affordable housing, free college tuition and child care.** Now, that's tasty!!
